The Trails Committee was formed as a subcommittee of the Lee Conservation Commission (LCC) in January 2021. According to New Hampshire RSA 36-A: 2, Conservation Commissions: The commission may appoint...subcommittees as it may require from time to time.

The Trails Committee consists of seven regular members including a Conservation Commission Liaison and up to seven alternate members. Meeting times, agendas and minutes of the Trails Committee are posted on the town website. The Trails Committee typically meets once per month, with work days scheduled depending on the need.

The Trails Committee is authorized by the Lee Select Board to maintain town trails. Individuals who are not on the Trails Committee are not authorized to do any work on the trails, including, but not limited to: sawing downed trees, moving downed trees off of the trail, building rock embankments, etc. If you are interested in working on the trails or see something that needs to be addressed, please contact the Chair of the Committee at leetrailscommittee@gmail.com.
